GOSPEL PRESENTATION

A. God's Position

1. *For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life* (John 3:16 NIV).
2. God loves man and wants to have fellowship with him.

B. Man's Condition

1. Man is a sinner and is unable to measure up to God's standard on his own.
2. *... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God* (Romans 3:23 NIV).
3. He cannot save himself *for it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God* (Ephesians 2:8 NIV).
4. Man's salvation must come from a source outside himself.

C. God's Provision

1. *For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God . . .* (1 Pet 3:18 NIV).
2. Jesus Christ, being God paid the penalty for man's sin. God sent Christ to pay for man's sin as man's substitute. What man could not do for himself, Jesus did.
